Major Details At-A-Glance

- 98 dB (A scale @ 50') sound limit
- Bikes and scooters only in identified limited areas
- Sunday runs will start earlier than usual, so plan ahead and be ready
- Shared parking with other groups; use parking space efficiently
- Tech/Scales/Waiver areas all near the grid and skid pad entrance; tech cars before running
- Indian Casino across the street from the event; entertainment and games of chance for those needing a diversion from the day's activities!
- Food vendor on site all three days
- No alcohol may be consumed on event site even after the days activities
- Course walking each evening from 5:00 to 7:00pm
- Event T-shirts (long & short sleeve) will be for sale at the Region's "Goodie Store" (*Collectors' items!!*)

The Arizona Region SCCA would like to welcome you to Firebird International Raceway, a facility known to many nationally for hosting both car and boat races.

Please respect the site and hosts, the neighbors, and each other by adhering to all safety, noise and event site conditions and requirements. To do so will enhance the experience for all involved.

Important Things To Know

Entering Firebird from Maricopa Road:

Head west on Maricopa road to gate three, enter by turning south (left) and proceed to the overhead gate. Parking will be to your left past grid and marked.

Noise - There will be a 98 dB (A scale @ 50') sound limit.

Bikes, Scooters, Etc.: Allowed only in the main parking areas, and may not be brought into the active grid/paddock area. They may be parked in the grid/paddock area at the entrance to the grid area.

Grid - Located due east of the actual autocross skidpad area outside the fencing.

2004 Rule Books: Will be available on site for purchase.

Parking – Will be due east and then north of the entrance to the course area.

Event Photographer - Photojournalist Cecil Walker (cecilwalker@hotmail.com) will be taking and selling action photos of the weekends' events. See him at his booth on the event site.

Alcohol - No alcohol may be consumed on site.

Tech/Scales/Waiver - All will be near the grid area in plain view marked with signs. All cars must be tech'd before running the Test and Tune or the event.

Contacting Event Officials - Go to the course entrance and state your needs. There will be someone there at all times with a radio to contact whomever you might need.

Goodie Store - Under an awning near the Tech area by the site entrance will be the Arizona Region Goodie Store with T-shirts and decals for sale. Limited hours of operation.

Friday Night - After 5:00pm Registration and Tech will open, as well as the course for walking. A food vendor will be available with a selection of light snacks and drinks.

Saturday Lunch: A food vendor with an variety of food choices will be available on site.

Saturday Night - After the event entrants, families and crew are encouraged to dine at one of the many fine restaurants in the nearby area; Macaroni Grill, Fogo E Brasa, Shadey O's, Z Tejas, Cracker Barrel, JB's Resturant, and even a Hooters! There is also a Casino across the road!
